

WOODWORKING SHOP VOLUNTEER SUPERVISOR
GOOD COMPANIONS SENIOR'S CENTRE

We are looking for a few experienced woodworkers to become volunteer supervisors for the GCC Woodworking Shop. A supervisor must be knowledgeable in the use and operating safety procedures for power and hand tools. The shop is equipped with a number of power tools including: table saw, 2 bandsaws, coping saw, jointer, thickness planer, power drill on stand, table top sanders, 2 lathers and assorted hand power tools as well as human powered hand tools.

The supervisor has to be able to assist any user in the use of the tools to maintain security and may also have to provide instruction on their use. One has to be a member of The Good Companions, age 55 or older and pay a yearly fee of \$21.00, and become a volunteer for The Good Companions (TGC) Woodworking Shop. This entails a police check as well as a certification in CPR and First Aid. The last two can be taken after one becomes a supervisor and are taught free of charge at TGC. The fees to use the workshop are \$32.00 per quarter reduced to \$16.00 after certification as a supervisor. As a supervisor one can make projects for themselves. The shop will be operating with a limit of four persons at a time due to COVID restrictions, one supervisor and three users. For safety reasons in order for the shop to open on a daily basis there must be a minimum of one supervisor and one user.
