



**Texture medium**/modeling paste is a mixture of marble dust and acrylic resin. It's designed to be used with acrylics, and its flexible base allows it to move with the wood.

About the texture of mayonnaise or soft icing, it can be molded, worked with knives or tools, or piped on to create 3-d shapes and textures.

Colour can be added with acrylic paints or other water-based paints, or it can be painted when dry.

The dried medium is very hard, slightly flexible, and can be sanded and carved.

Applying to wood that has been painted with acrylic (brush or spray) or sealed with acrylic finish (brush or spray) is best.
